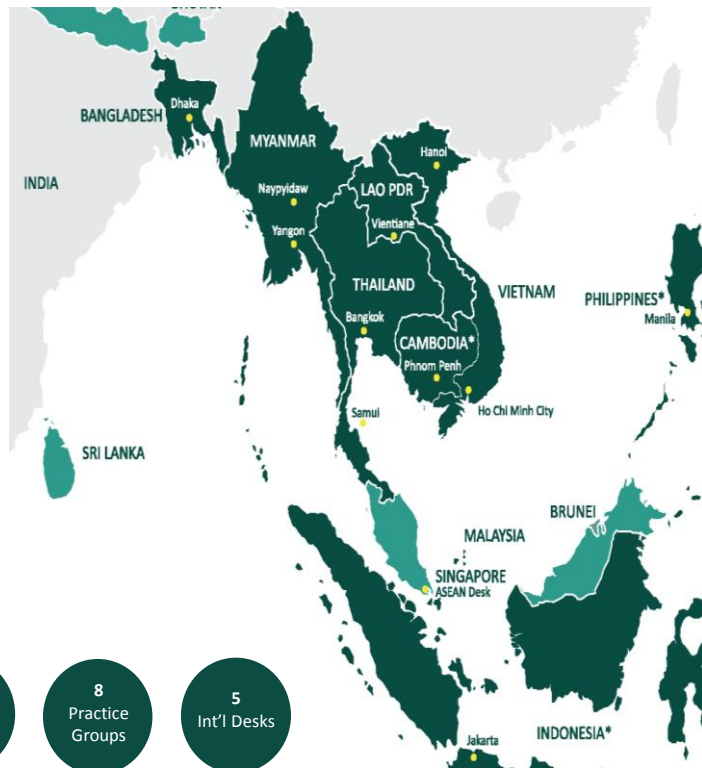


ASEAN DESK IN SINGAPORE
